M/s KOSCOVE E-WASTE PRIVATE LIMITED (Legal Name :KOSCOVE E-WASTE PRIVATE LIMITED) is hereby granted registration for recycling of Waste Battery in line with provisions under Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022:

The registration shall be valid for a period of five years from date of issue of this letter unless revoked / suspended / cancelled. The registration is granted subject to the following terms & conditions:

1. It shall be the responsibility of the recycler to,-
 - i. (i).ensure that it carries out any activity in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by Central Pollution Control Board
 - ii. (ii).ensure that hazardous waste generated from any activity of the entity is managed as per the provisions under Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016
 - iii. (iii).ensure that other waste generated during handling and recycling activities be managed as per the extant regulations such as Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 and e-waste (Management) Rules, 2016;
 - iv. (iv).ensure that recycling processes and facilities for Waste Battery comply with the standards or guidelines prescribed by Central Pollution Control Board;
 - v. (v).ensure that the Waste Battery is removed from collected appliance if Battery is incorporated in an equipment.;
2. Entities involved in recycling of Waste Battery, registered under these rules shall provide EPR certificates for Waste Battery processing. The amount of Waste Battery recycled by the entity shall not be more than installed capacity of the entity.
3. The certificate for Waste Battery provided by recyclers shall be provided for the type and quantity of Battery recycled and can be transacted for meeting Extended Producer Responsibility obligations. The exchange of EPR certificates

between Producers and Recyclers to be done as per mechanism provided by CPCB.

4. Recyclers shall furnish the quarterly returns in Form 4 regarding the information on quantity of Waste Battery collected or received from various producers or entity, recycled quantities, compliance of material-wise recovery percentage as per recovery targets provided under sub-rule 4 of rule 10, quantity of hazardous and/or other waste including solid waste or plastic waste generated after recycling and of such quantity as per as per extant rules and the quarterly return shall be filed by the end of the month succeeding the end of the quarter.
5. Recycler shall not deal with any other entity not having registration mandated under these rules.
6. CPCB can suspend and / or cancel the registration and / or impose Environment Compensation in case of non-compliance of Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022.
7. Any violation of the provision(s) of the Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022 will attract the penal provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986).
